What data is processed?

As part of your participation in the WienMobil Rad Challenge, we collect the following personal data via the competition landing page:

- First name and surname
- Telephone number
- Email address

In addition, during the competition period, an automated comparison is carried out with your existing nextbike account in order to determine the number of WienMobil Rad rentals you have made and to select the winner. This comparison is carried out exclusively on the basis of the telephone number you provided during registration.

What happens if you win?

If you have completed the highest number of rentals during the competition period, you will be deemed the winner. In this case, we will transfer your first name, surname and email address to our cooperation partner:

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Legal basis for processing

Your data is processed on the basis of your consent in accordance with **Article 6(1)(a) GDPR**, provided when you register for the competition.

Storage period

We store your data exclusively for the purpose of administering the competition and delete it no later than **one month after the competition has ended**, unless statutory retention obligations prevent deletion.

The winner's data will be deleted by nextbike after it has been transferred to Wiener Linien. Any further processing by Wiener Linien will be carried out in accordance with its own privacy policy.

Your rights

Under the GDPR, you have the following rights:

- Right of access (Article 15 GDPR)
- Right to rectification (Article 16 GDPR)
- Right to erasure (Article 17 GDPR)
- Right to restriction of processing (Article 18 GDPR)
- Right to data portability (Article 20 GDPR)
- Right to withdraw your consent with effect for the future (Article 7(3) GDPR)
- Right to lodge a complaint with a data protection supervisory authority (Article 77 GDPR)
